Souderton Area School District student art on display for Youth Art Month

TELFORD >> The Indian Valley Public Library was filled with Souderton Area School District students, family members and friends for the official artist reception March 16, during which students showcased some works from their art classes this school year.

The exhibit, which includes about 450 pieces of artwork, is on display for the entire month of March.

“It’s a community event,” said Ginny Perry, an art teacher at Souderton Area High School and the district’s art coordinator for the secondary grades.

Types of art in the show include two-dimensional and three-dimensional works, drawings, paintings, collages and mixed media, she said.

“It’s a little bit of everything,” said Kim Minnucci, West Broad Street Elementary School art teacher and the district’s art coordinator for the elementary grades.

With many good examples of student art available, narrowing it down to the ones in the exhibit is difficult, she said.

The artworks are from students in each of the grades and students of each of the district’s art teachers, Minnucci and Perry said.

Some high school students had as many as four of their works in the exhibit, Perry said. For the elementary students, it was limited to one per student, Minnucci said.
