Assistant Superintendent and Director of Human Resources Dr. Christopher Hey read the following public comments:

To the School Board,

My name is Elizabeth Hirschmann, I have 5 kids in the district, 3 at Indian Crest, and 2 at the High school. and one in Kindergarten at All my Children (who goes **full time** there).

I am a single working mom, and this is a disaster. I have rearranged my schedule to be home with them, but if I am not here babysitting them the whole time, the confusion because of the lack of consistency between assignment postings wins, and no work gets done. PLEASE, I cannot keep this up. It is chaos here. Frustrated kids, doing subpar work, and learning nothing, doing busy work. There will be so many kids who fall through the cracks. That being said, my 10th grader is in class all day online, and engaging with her teachers live in real time. This seems to be a better model.

Thank you for your Pioneering Spirit to be the only district to attempt to go back in Person.

Are the reopening plans that were disgusted in August still the same? Will the children be able to go back to school in person for 5 days starting Tuesday, September 29? Julie Yoder

Like last month, I respectfully ask that this comment be read at tonight's meeting and not simply logged within a group of like sentiments.

As teachers in the Souderton Area School District, SAEA is committed to educating and looking out for the welfare of all children. We are grateful for the sacrifices that our families and students made since March under the most difficult of circumstances, and we are eager to return to school as normal. We know the best option for students is face-to-face interaction with their teachers and peers. We also know that measures need to be in place to make sure that is done safely.

SAEA understands that a national pandemic is something SASD has never had to deal with before. As mandates and conditions changed, we too had to pivot and change. None of it has been easy for anyone, but we knew it had to be done for the health and safety of all. The School Board did just that in August when you voted for the true hybrid model we have been using. It wasn't an easy decision, but you knew for the health and welfare of all involved, it was the correct decision. However, there is now concern, more than ever, that as a district we are not prepared to safely reopen our doors on Tuesday to all of our students who chose in-person education. We are still classified as moderate, just like we were in August. Yet here we are moving forward with the model you wisely avoided before.

Though the district's efforts to change the physical learning environments are commendable, it is not possible for students and staff to maintain the 6 feet of physical distancing that is recommended by the Montgomery County Health Department. After the county directed the closure of West Broad Street Elementary for two weeks, teachers across the district were told to be diligent about maintaining the 6 feet of separation in classrooms. The 6 feet separation is not possible for many in the current hybrid. How will we make that work on 9/29 with everyone back in our buildings and large class sizes? We can't and that puts everyone at risk, students, families, community members as well as all our district personnel.

Seating was changed in our cafeterias to increase the distance between students. In some buildings, there is not enough seating for all the students during lunch in the hybrid. It will only be worse if the entire student body is present.

I am asking you, SASD Administrators and School Board, to be dedicated to a safe reopening and not simply a reopening of our buildings

Dr. Gallagher responded that the school district is sticking with its plan to reopen all schools for students who selected in-school instruction, on Tuesday, September 29th, for five days per week.

Dr. Gallagher also stated that the school district is adhering to the 3', 4', and 6' distancing wherever and whenever feasible. He noted that the 6' when feasible is a recommendation from the Montgomery County Department of Public Health and primarily used in their contract tracing efforts. Dr. Gallagher stated that he and the administration are in almost daily communication with County Commissioner Dr. Val Arkoosh and she had indicated that many neighboring schools are also beginning a phase in to in-

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person instruction. She also said that Montgomery County has been quite successful in its efforts to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 through its efforts of PPE and intentional measures of social distancing.

Dr. Gallagher noted that the student compliance with the wearing of face coverings has been very good. He said that the school district will continue to work with the Montgomery County Department of Public Health and that safety remains a top priority. He also stated that if circumstances change, and a spike in virus cases would occur, that the school district will pivot its instruction model as needed.

Mr. Keith thanked the community for its support and reiterated the Board's confidence in providing a safe instructional environment for students and staff both on-line and in-person. Mr. Keith also commented on the continuance and importance of district communication.

Dr. Gallagher gave an update on the district Equity Committee. He said that in addition to the steering team, a representative from each of the schools, members of the community and parents have been added to the committee. He stated that the professional organization P.A.S.A. (PA Association of School Administrators) just implemented a series of equity webinars titled "Cultivating A Culture of Social Justice & Equity." The webinars are recorded and will be made available to committee members as a resource. Dr. Gallagher also said that the M.C.I.U. (Montgomery County Intermediate Unit) has also begun supporting school districts with equity issues and concerns will have its first virtual presentation in October.

Dr. Gallagher also announced that once students have returned to school, the high school will resume the meetings of the Multi Cultural Club. This club was started three years ago by Mr. Stanton and Mrs. Sykes and had over 70 students in attendance. The club invites guest speakers from outside the school community to prompt discussions on diversity and equity. Dr. Gallagher said it is the goal to expand the Multi Cultural Club beyond the high school to the middle and elementary schools.
