Below you will find the expectations we are working towards so that everyone is safe and happy during recess and lunch!

Cafeteria Expectations:	Playground Expectations:
<p>Children are to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Sit in their assigned seat ● Raise their hand if they need something or if they need to use the bathroom ● Use polite manners: “please” and “thank you” ● Use inside voices (talking to friends directly next to or across) ● Clean up their trash on the table and the floor. ● Eat their own food (no sharing) <p>In addition to reminding our students of these expectations, children may need assistance moving efficiently through the lunch line and opening juice boxes and packages.</p>	<p>Children are to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Use equipment safely <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -feet first down the slide -bottoms on the swings (not bellies or feet) -no climbing up the slides ● Play tag in grassy areas and the blacktop (not on or under the playsets). ● Stay in the playground area (not behind the shed, not behind the swings, not past the activity path). ● Tell a grown-up if a ball goes over the fence or outside of the playground area ● Line up right when the whistle blows. ● Line up quietly before entering the building.
