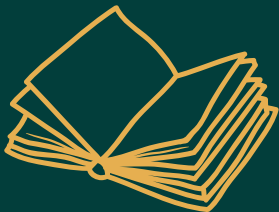

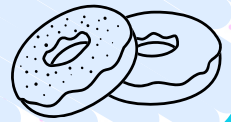
October School Wide Challenge

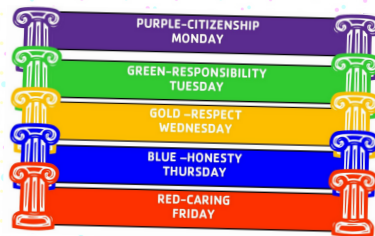
