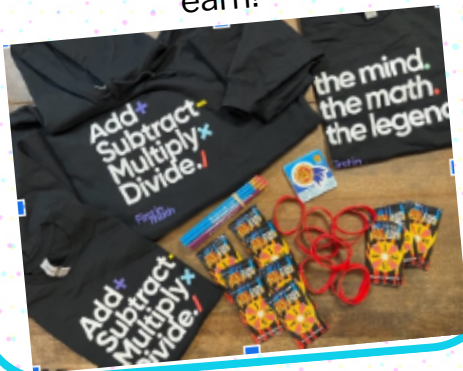
Teaching Girls Tech
