IMPORTANT PARENT INFORMATION

Dear Parents,

Welcome to kindergarten! I am very excited to be your child's kindergarten teacher this year! Below you will find some important information to help you as you get ready for our exciting kindergarten year.....

BACKPACKS ~ please help your child select a backpack large enough to hold a 12x11 folder and a library book. Please help your child practice zipping and unzipping and taking things in and out of it.

FOLDERS ~ Your child will receive a "take home" folder on their first day. They should bring this folder back and forth to school each day. This will help us get important information to and from school. Please check your child's folder everyday and remove papers.

SUPPLIES ~ We will have our own personal supplies this year. Please see the kindergarten supply list on our Franconia page on the district website. Please place the starred items in your child's pencil box for the first day.

SNACKS ~ kindergarteners do work up an appetite! Please send your child with a healthy snack each day. It should be something they can open and eat with ease and in a few minutes (applesauce, squeeze bottles, granola bars, peeled or cut fruit or vegetables are all great options). Please refrain from sending any snacks that contain nuts until I find out if our classroom is a nut-free room. Thank you!

WATER BOTTLES ~ please send a non-spill water bottle with your child's name on it each day.

ABSENT NOTES ~ If your child is absent a written absence note is due within 3 days of their return in order to be excused. You may send it in your child's folder and I will send it to the office. You can use the forms provided by school or any paper note is accepted.

FAMILY TRIPS ~ If your child will be missing school due to a family trip or other planned absence a written note must be submitted to the school office PRIOR to your trip so that it will be an excused absence.

CLOTHING ~ When selecting an outfit for school, comfy clothing with minimal zippers and buttons work best for using the bathroom. Sneakers are always a good option for the playground and physical education day.

RECESS ~ we do try to go outside everyday (weather permitting). Please make sure your child is dressed and prepared for outdoor weather.

SPECIALS ~ your child will attend a special class each day. You will receive a special schedule on the first day of school in your child's folder. It is important to have sneakers on physical education day and library books on library day.

LUNCH ~ Your child will be eating lunch here at school each day. Please send their lunch in a lunchbox or bag clearly labeled with their name. Buying lunch at school is always an option. Information about school lunches can be found on our district website.

We will go over more about our classroom together at our Back to School Night in September. Look for more information about that special night coming soon!
