

Senior Project Cheat Sheet

Congratulations Seniors! It is now time for you to share your accomplishments and challenges over the past 3+ years, and how those experiences will prepare you for your next steps. Below are a few bullet points about what to expect on the day of your senior presentation...

Parameters:

- **Most seniors will present in November**
- *Spring presentations are only for students who have been approved to do so*
 - Typically this is due to a mentorship-in-progress or Spring Ed Internship
 - Please see Mrs. Tarlo or Mr. Darcy with questions.
- **NMTCC Students** - Will not present
- **Senior/2nd Semester Junior transfer students** - will not present, they will have an exit interview with the Career Counselor in the Spring
 - Mr. Darcy met with you to discuss expectations.

Key Points:

- Make sure you pick a date on this [FORM](#). (Form will be in your email)
 - **VACATIONS:** *Not an excused absence...sign up for the date you are not going away*
- You will be scheduled for a time and a room.
 - Please pay close attention to your school email for updates.
- **Dress for Success...**you should be the best dressed person in the room!
- Remember, this is not about being right or wrong, it is all about us wanting to know more about you...so **TELL YOUR STORY!**

Procedure:

Prior to your presentation date:

- Upload your presentation to Google slides...that will be the platform used to present
- Prior to the presentation, upload you Culminating reflection in pathwayMANAGER
 - All other reflections should have been uploaded in previous years
 - Culminating reflection should be completed by the day of your presentation.
- Make sure any outstanding documentation for mentorships and/or job shadows has been submitted.
- Update your resume
 - **NEW: If helpful, you can build your resume in pathwayMANAGER using a new tool. At the top of the screen, click on MORE, then RESUME**

 - Watch the bottom 2 for the most recent examples
- Review the [Senior Project Rubric](#).

On the day of your presentation:

- Arrive early!
- Bring 3 printed copies of your updated resume
 - **NOTE: This is the only paperwork you need. Your reflections will be viewed directly in pathwayMANAGER.**
- Log into the teacher's device connected to the TV in the room and open your presentation in Google.
- Take a breath, count to 10, and present.

This is a great day for everyone! You will do well...remember to TELL YOUR STORY!
