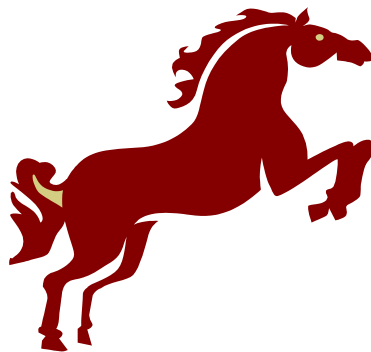
Parent Email—If you are not already signed up to receive parent emails from your child's school and the district, you can do so on your child's school website under parent resources.

Students should keep their locker combination private and not share with friends or

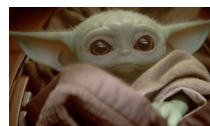
fellow students.
