Indian Valley Middle School will be hosting our **8th Annual Community Day on Friday, May 16, 2025**. Each grade level will operate on their own schedule, but their days encompass the following events:

IVMS COMMUNITY DAY ACTIVITIES

- **Volunteering:** All students will engage in approximately 2.5 hours of volunteer service during Community Day. This year students will have the opportunity to choose between the volunteer opportunities listed below:
 1. **Bracelet/Card Making:** Students will make bracelets and/or cards to be donated to a local organization (Grades 6-8).
 2. **Wiffleball Challenge:** Students will raise money to participate in a wiffleball tournament on the day of the event. Each child needs to raise \$10 in order to participate. Money collected will be managed by the IVMS Community Day Club and used to support IVMS students and families experiencing hardships. (Grades 6-8)
 3. **Off Campus Volunteering (8th GRADE ONLY):** 8th graders will have a third option. They will be able to be bussed off campus to volunteer at district elementary schools, SAHS, Perkiomen Watershed, and the YMCA.
- **Outdoor Challenge:** All Indian Valley Middle School students are invited to participate in the Outdoor Challenge located on the school's property.
- **Grade Level Picnic:** Grade levels come together to enjoy some outside activities together as well as a treat to enjoy!

VALLEY VOLUNTEERS!

To emphasize the importance of volunteer work as a lifelong activity, we will be encouraging Valley students to complete volunteer hours prior to the start of Community Day. Starting in early April, students will be able to start completing volunteer activities in the community. This can be acts of kindness done for neighbors or service done for a local charity.

Parents will log hours for students during the months of April and May, and the grade with the most hours will win a prize on Community Day.

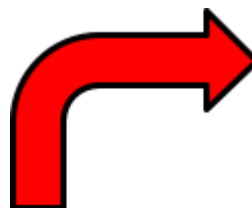
SUPPORT COMMUNITY DAY- WATER BALLOON FUN!
